How Individuals, Families, Businesses, and Scouting Units can contribute to Scouting in Western Colorado in 2016



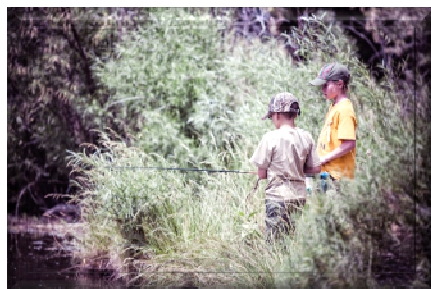
## Fair Share Campaign

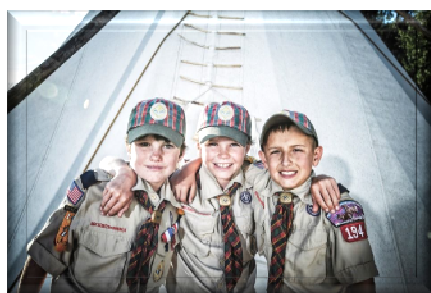
## Friends of Scouting
